Domestic Violence can take the form of :

- ◆ Physical Abuse
- ◆ Emotional Abuse (including threats)
- ◆ Sexual Abuse
- ◆ Neglect
- ◆ Stalking

Domestic violence of a senior is abuse committed by a family member, partner, spouse, caregiver or someone the senior lives with.

Who is Eligible: California victims of domestic violence over 60

How we can help:

Statewide: We can help senior domestic violence victims with a wide variety of civil legal issues. For example, we may be able to help you get a restraining order, a divorce, public benefits or stop an illegal eviction. We are also able to connect clients to other local resources available to them through our network of nonprofit and government agencies.

Sacramento County Residents: Besides helping you with legal matters related to domestic violence, we can often help you get a restraining order.
